



MANAGEMENT OF THE APPLICATION PROCESS – REQUIREMENTS

In the following link you have the application form to be completed by students <https://www.upv.es/entidades/SA/ciclos/409043normali.html>, to be sent along with the rest of the documentation indicated, to this address: sestu.grado@upv.es.

In the application you must indicate and/or attach the following:

- **Degree from the UPV** in which you wish to be a Visiting student <https://www.upv.es/estudios/grado/index-en.html>

In the previous link, when selecting the Degree you can consult the Study Plan and the subjects. The course registration fees are available by accessing the information for each of the degrees.

- **Subjects in which you request to enroll** as a visiting student (indicating the corresponding code). If you are interested in subjects from different degrees, you must complete an application for each Degree. The description of each subject indicates the period of its teaching. **There may be a limit on the number of places available.**

The 2026/2027 academic year begins on September 1, 2026, Semester A begins classes on September 7 and ends on January 29, 2027, Semester B teaches from February 1 to June 25, with the end of the course on August 31, 2027.

- **Proof of completing or having** completed university studies (attach a copy of the transcript or registration at the University)
- You must attach an **identification document**, copy of passport, or DNI (Spanish)

Once we have these documents, the Dean's Office or Directorate of the Faculty or School that teaches the Degree in which you are interested will issue a report on the possibility of admission as a visiting student.

Subsequently, the Rector will issue a Resolution accepting or denying admission as a visiting student.

You must have **medical insurance** that covers any medical contingency during your stay at the University (to be provided at the Center where you are going to study, in the case of admission and prior to formalizing registration).

Once the studies have been completed, the student has the option of obtaining an academic certificate with the grades obtained from their intranet.

- APPLICABLE FEES

According to [Decree 101/2024, of August 2](#), of the Consell de la Generalitat Valenciana, foreign students who do not have resident status, excluding nationals of the member states of the European Union and those to whom the community regime applies, when registering for admitted studies, must pay double the public prices for university academic services. Students who have a residence permit for study stays are considered non-residents for these purposes.

- LINGUISTIC REQUIREMENT:

If the degree requested requires a linguistic requirement, given that teaching is carried out in Spanish, and in order to ensure that the student is capable of following all the training activities, accreditation of a **B2 level of Spanish**, certified in accordance with the Regulations, **may be required** for the admission of students from non-Spanish-speaking countries. Students from Spanish-speaking countries or those who have completed their studies in educational systems that use Spanish as their primary language will be exempt from this accreditation.
